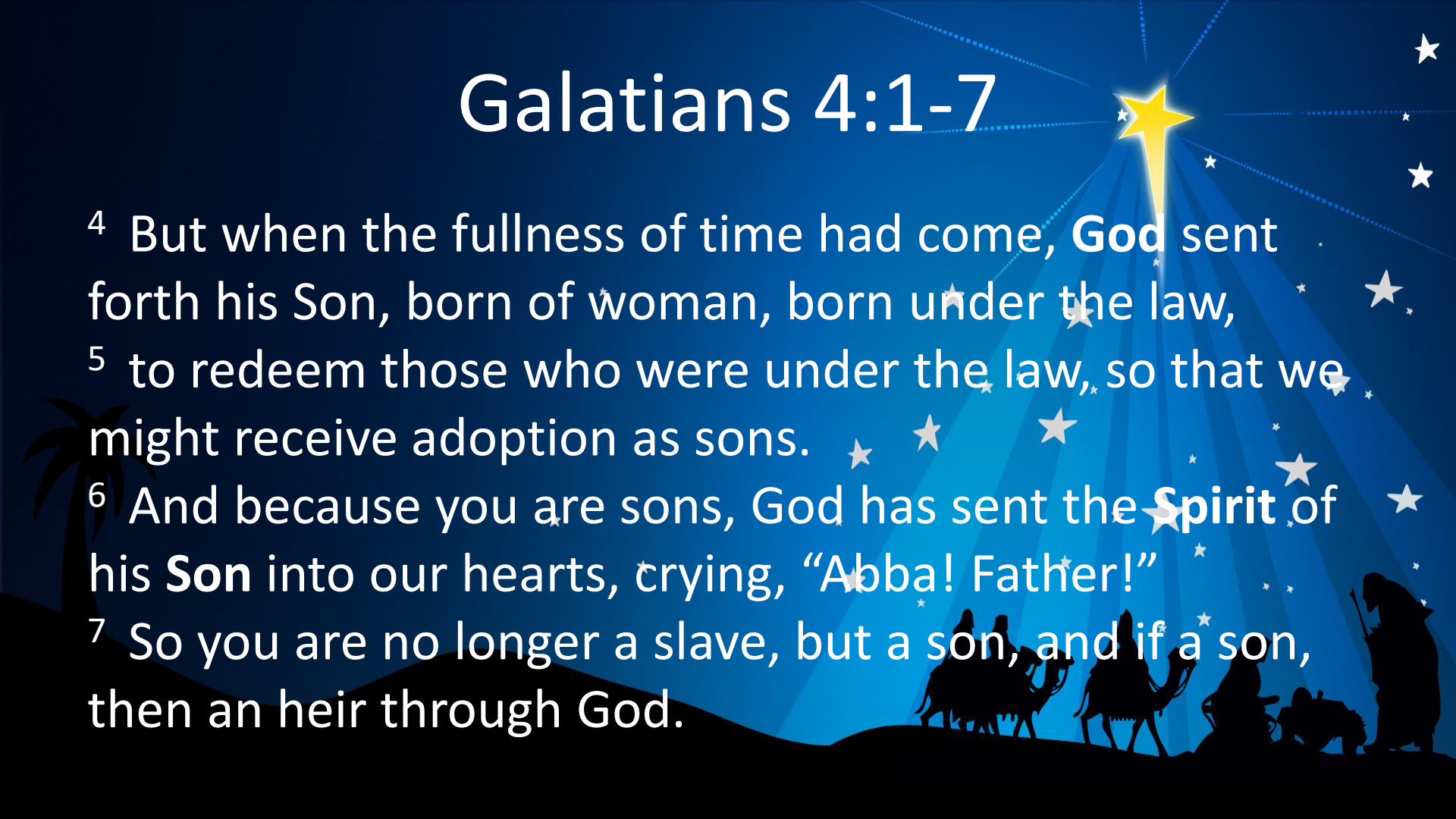

Galatians 4:1-7

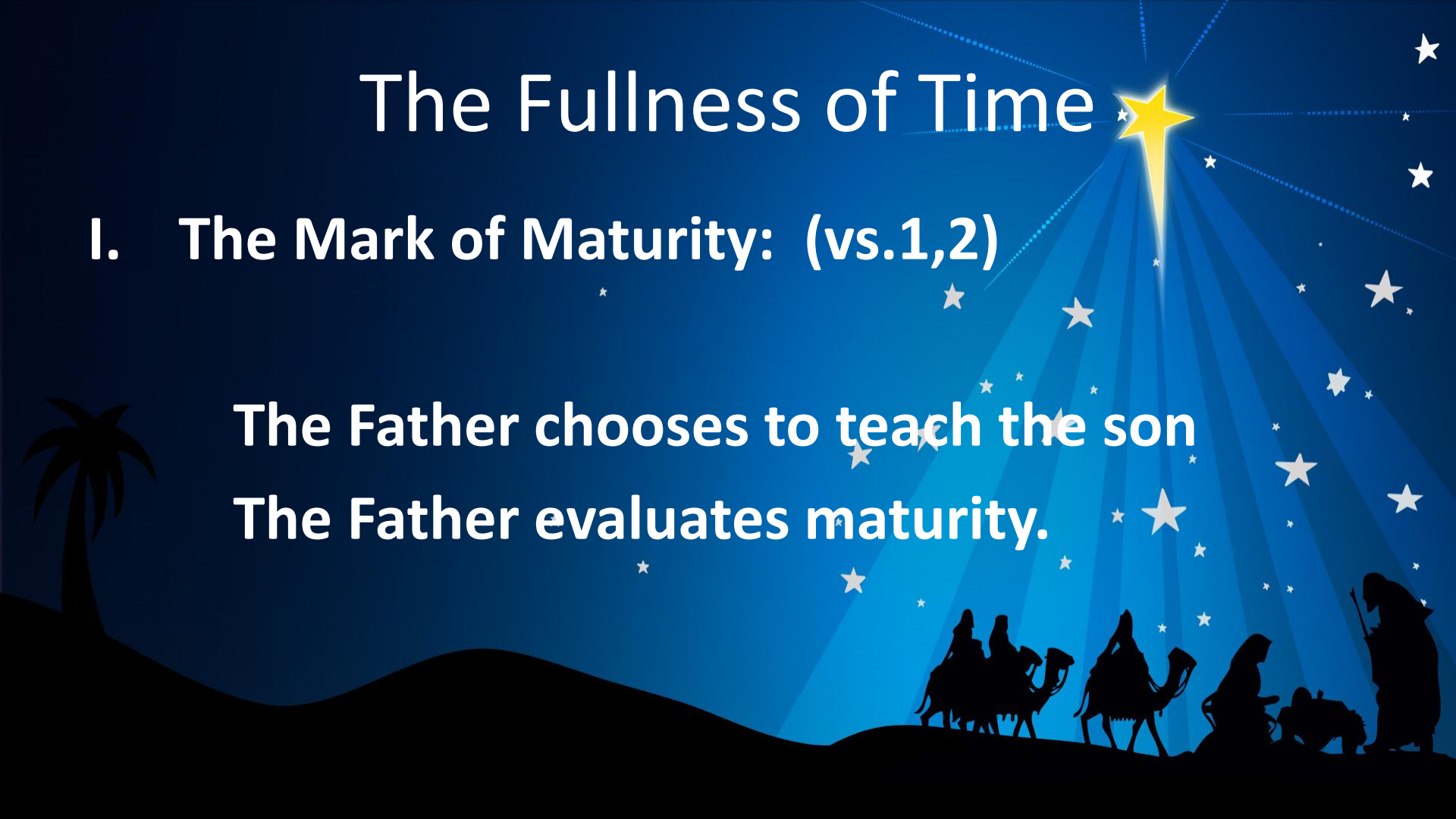
- ⁴ But when the fullness of time had come, **God** sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law,
